

Communication with I&APs

Regulation 21 of the EIA Regulations details the steps to be taken during a public consultation process and these have been used in guiding this process. Communication with I&APs with regard to the proposed development was facilitated through the following means and in this order:

- A Background Information Document (BID) containing brief information about the proposed exploration works was compiled and emailed to pre-identified I&APs, and upon request to all new registered I&APs;
- Project Environmental Assessment notices were published in The Namibian and New Era Newspaper (09th April 2024 and 16th April 2024), briefly explaining the activity and its locality, inviting members of the public to register as I&APs and submit their comments/concerns.
- Site notices with information about the project and the meeting were placed at the Pick n Pay Swakopmung Erongo Region.
- Consultation meeting was scheduled and held at Ministry of Environment, Forestry, and Tourism office, 09h00, with the I&APs.




Figure 13: Public notices placed at Pick n Pay Swakopmund, Erongo region Namibia







Namibian coach reaps rewards in Dubai

ROBIN du Toit, a prominent Namibian sport scientist, coach and founder of ArtistFit, is the first Namibian coach to secure a world championship title in strength sport.

Under his guidance, athlete Brenda Theron emerged victorious in the under-75 women's category at the World Strongman Championship held in Dubai on 28 March, marking a significant moment in their collaborative journey.

Hailing from Otiwarongo, Du Toit's passion for sport and dedication to excellence were cultivated during his time at Edugate Academy and Noordgrens Rund, before pursuing advanced studies in Potchefstroom.

His expertise spans various disciplines, including power lifting, strongman and woman, mixed martial arts, boxing and rugby, establishing himself as a formidable force in the coaching realm. The triumphant partnership between Du Toit and Theron highlights their shared commitment to redefining the narrative in strength sport. Theron's victory not only highlights her exceptional talent and perseverance, but also reflects Du Toit's strategic coaching approach and unwavering support.

"I am incredibly proud of Brenda's achievement and grateful for the opportunity to contribute to her success," Du Toit says. "This victory is a testament to our teamwork, dedication and shared vision for advancing the standards in strength sport."

Du Toit's vision extends beyond mere victories, emphasising the importance of fostering femininity among women strength athletes and promoting a holistic, athletic approach to competitions. Their collective efforts have garnered international recognition, setting a new benchmark for excellence in the realm of strength and contact sport coaching.

As he prepares for the upcoming Static Monsters World Championships in July, Du Toit says he is gearing up with another athlete. Looking ahead, he says he plans to transition from strength sport to rugby in the next two years.
