## SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION REGARDING THE LOCATION OF EXCLUSIVE PROSPECTING LICENCES (EPLS) 9441 AND 9800

We are writing to bring to your attention a matter of spatial jurisdiction concerning (EPLs) **9441** and **9800**.

Based on a detailed review of the licensed areas, we wish to formally state that the areas covered by the aforementioned EPLs fall entirely within the confines of private farmland. This is clearly delineated on the attached map, which overlays the EPL boundaries with the registered cadastral boundaries.

We are providing this information to ensure that your departments records are accurate and to facilitate clear communication regarding regulatory oversight and any required consent letters as the screening process has requested for consent letter from a relevant traditional authority which is no where near the licenses. Therefore, understanding the precise location is crucial for applying the correct regulatory context and for our ongoing farm management planning.

We also wish to bring to your attention that the heritage survey is in progress and once completed a Archeological Heritage Assessment report shall be provided to your office together with he consent from National Heritage Council.
