- (c) In terms of Section 87 & 88 of the Urban and Regional Planning Act, (Act no. 5 of 2018), as amended, read in conjunction with sections 105(1) (e) of the same Act no. 5 of 2018, the subdivision of portion x of Kabeljou & Benguela street reserve in extent of 369m² and remainder of the street be approved
- (d) In terms of Section 87 & 88 of the Urban and Regional Planning Act, (Act no. 5 of 2018), as amended, read in conjunction with sections 105(1) (e) of the same Act no. 5 of 2018, the closure & subsequent rezoning of portion x of Kabeljou & Benguela street reserve in extent of 369m² from "Street" to "Parastatal", be approved;
- (e) The intended alienation be advertised in two local newspapers for two consecutive weeks, the applicant to bear the cost for such placements in the printed media.

- (f) The proposed Land development be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Environmental Management Act of 2007, to comply with the requirements of Environmental Impact assessment (EIA).

- (h) Developers pay 10% of the purchase price upon approval and 90% within 90 days after initial approval.
