- a) A buffer zone of 100 m should be created and maintained around stone tools, rock shelter with deposit of stone tools, burials located within the EPL.
- b) A buffer zone of 3 km buffer zone should be created and maintained around the rock art paintings
- c) Monitoring and evaluation inspection will be carried out on the area during the course of the year.
- d) Failure to adhere to the conditions will attract fines or imprisonment or the retraction of the consent as per the National Heritage Act no. 27 of 2004.
- e) As per Section 55 (9) (a) the activity authorized by this consent be supervised by a person with appropriate professional qualifications or experience.
- f) The proponent should take caution approaches together with the compliance and of the Chance Find Procedure.
- g) The consent holder is to report back to the National Heritage Council every six (6) months on compliance with the conditions of this consent.
