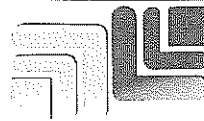
FINAL REMARKS AND CONCLUSION OF THE MEETING

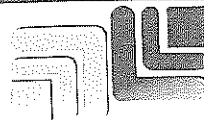
FINAL REMARKS AND CONCLUSION OF THE MEETING

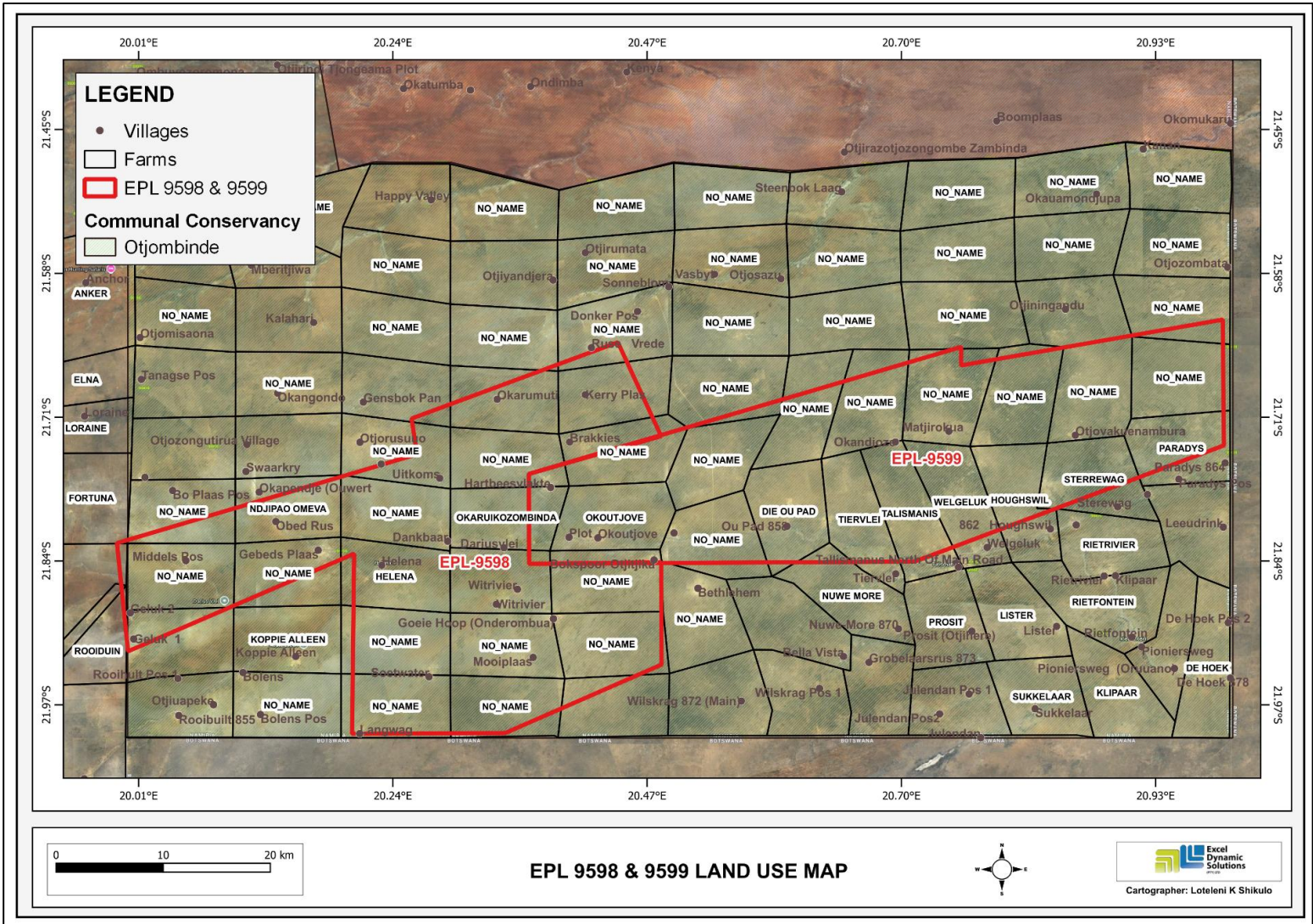
