According to the released Preliminary Economic Assessment (PEA) of the Haib Copper Project in southern Namibia, the project will require 20 million cubic metres of water, and this can potentially be piped from Namibia's Neckartal storage dam (a distance of 260km between the two).

The developer of the project, Koryx Copper Inc, released the results of the PEA this week.

Revealing their water requirements per year, they said it would be from a hybrid solution of Orange River water (30km distance) and potentially piped from Namibia's Neckartal Dam.

Furthermore, the results have revealed that the mine will require 150MW of maximum power demand to be sourced through the nearby Namibian grid, plus supplementary hybrid renewable power and battery energy storage.

The mine is projected to have a production rate of 92,000 tonnes per annum, an upfront capital cost of US\$1.56bn, and a projected mine life of 23 years.

The Haib is a porphyry copper exploration project located in the Karas Region of southern Namibia.

Commenting on the PEA, Heye Daun, Koryx Copper's president, stated that they are encouraged by the good results of this PEA, notwithstanding the fact that it is still based on the 2024 Mineral Resource model and does not yet reflect all of the notable drill results produced since late 2024.

He said the project is made unique by a number of attributes: simplicity, scalability, low risk, ideal location at low altitude, close proximity to water and power infrastructure, with low capital intensity and operating costs.

Daun also added that the project has a predictable permitting environment and a lack of any technical, environmental, or social fatal flaws.

"This suggests that this project could be rendered shovel-ready, with an advanced feasibility study, secure water and power supply, and most major permits in place within just a few years," he stated.

Koryx Copper Inc. has a 100% interest in Deep South Mining Company (Pty) Ltd., a Namibian subsidiary, which in turn has a 100% interest in Haib Minerals (Pty) Ltd, which holds the exploration rights to the Haib Project.

Exclusive Prospecting Licence 3140 ("EPL 3140") allows for the exploration of base, rare and precious metals over an area of 36,589 hectares.

The Haib Mineral Resource estimate included information obtained from diamond drillholes completed between 1963 and 2024, with drilling comprising a total length of 78,934 m.

In addition, one underground adit was channel sampled over a length of 126 m.

According to the project developer, the historical data was validated, and all data collected by Rio Tinto Zinc (120 drillholes from 1972 to 1975), Great Fitzroy Mines (13 drillholes from 1995 to 1999), and Teck (32 drillholes in 2010) were accepted for use in the mineral resource estimate.

Capital Continues to Flood Govt Debt Instruments

...N\$3.3 billion in Capital Sought Space on TBs this Week

The tender result of the three Treasury Bills (T-Bills) auction that was carried out yesterday shows that investors have submitted bids worth N\$3.3 billion in the quest to lend to the government through its short-term instruments.

This is in response to a tender invite where the government wanted to borrow N\$1.4 billion through the four treasury bills, namely the 91-day T-bill, 182-day T-bill, 273-day T-bill, and 364-day T-bill.

The government sought N\$370 million through the 91-day T-Bill, instead seeing N\$555.8 million worth of bids during the auction seeking a growth avenue.

However, the government only ended up borrowing what it offered.

Through the 182-day T-bill government wanted the same amount (N\$370 million), and during the auction N\$968.5 million was submitted by the investors.

This made it the most sought-after instrument at this auction.

Again, the government only took the initial offered amount, nothing more.

As for the 237-day T-bill, which is the second-longest short-term debt option of the government, it also received plenty of capital in bidding - N\$903.3 million - even though the government only required N\$370 million.

The 364-day T-bill garnered 37 bids during yesterday's auction, amounting

to N\$890.2 billion. However, the government only accepted the N\$370 million it needed.

This means N\$1.3 billion was unused at this auction, remaining with investors.

This is because all the T-Bills were oversubscribed, with three of them by more than 2 times.
