

# Chinese premier says SCO can play greater role in promoting good global governance



The Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO)

The Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) is equipped and capable of taking the joint implementation of the Global Governance Initiative (GGI) as an opportunity to play a greater role in bringing the world under good governance, Chinese Premier Li Qiang said on Tuesday.

Li made the remarks when addressing the 24th Meeting of the Council of Heads of Government of Member States of the SCO. Leaders and representatives from SCO members, observers and dialogue partners, guests of the host country, as well as leaders of international organizations attended the meeting, which was chaired by Russian Prime Minister Mikhail Mishustin.

Chinese President Xi Jinping solemnly put forth the GGI at the SCO Tianjin Summit in September, offering Chinese wisdom and solutions to help the international community jointly address global transformation and urgent challenges, Li said.

He underscored the SCO's importance in building and reforming the global governance system.

Firstly, the SCO should leverage its unique strengths, Li said.

Noting that the Shanghai Spirit is highly aligned with the core concepts of the GGI, Li said that the SCO has extensive practical experience and solid institutional guarantees, and should make full use of these advantages to make greater contributions to global governance and help build a community with a shared future for humanity.

Secondly, the SCO should focus on the key areas of development and security, he said.

He urged SCO countries to promote development and security through cooperation, enhance the alignment of development strategies, promote high-quality Belt and Road cooperation, ensure the stability and smooth flow of global industrial and supply chains, and jointly build an open and inclusive world economy.

He said China stands ready to work closely with all SCO members to establish the SCO Development Bank as soon as possible and proposes the establishment of a China-SCO cooperation center for metabolic diseases. Li also called for efforts to strengthen security cooperation mechanisms, give full play to the important role of the four security centers, and work with the international community to jointly uphold multilateralism and promote universal security and lasting peace.

Thirdly, the SCO should stimulate strong vitality for innovation and transformation, he said. He urged joint efforts to strengthen cooperation in science and technology as well as industrial innovation, and promote cooperation on traditional energy and renewable energy.

Li said China welcomes the active participation of all parties in the SCO Digital Economy Forum and the China-SCO Artificial Intelligence Cooperation Forum, adding that China is willing to jointly build and make good use of the China-SCO digital economy cooperation platform and the sci-tech innovation cooperation center, and steadily increase the installed capacity of photovoltaic and wind power each by 10 million kilowatts in the next five years.

Li pointed out that leaders at the SCO Tianjin Summit jointly approved the development strategy for the SCO in the 2026-2035 period. He said China is willing to work with all member countries to pay more attention to strategic coordination, effectively promote the implementation of cooperation, optimize and improve the operation mechanism, further enhance cohesion, capacity for action, and influence, and continuously make the SCO better and stronger.

Other parties attending the meeting noted that the SCO is playing an increasingly pivotal role in promoting regional integration and facilitating the establishment of a just and equitable multipolar world. They called on all parties to join hands to implement the outcomes of the SCO Tianjin Summit, optimize the organization's mechanism, align with the Belt and Road Initiative, and implement the SCO's development strategy for the 2026-2035 period.

They also urged various sides to bolster cooperation in areas such as connectivity, economy and trade, security, as well as people-to-people exchanges, implement the GGI, and safeguard multilateralism and the central role of the United Nations. Following the meeting, Li and other leaders signed the joint communique and cooperation documents concerning economy and trade, railways, social development and security, and approved relevant resolutions on the construction of the SCO.



Nobody will invite the youth to this skills revolution. They must join it, willingly, boldly and without apology.

## CRAN disconnects UCOM network


The Communications Regulatory Authority of Namibia (CRAN) has disconnected the network of UCOM Mobile Namibia after confiscating its radio equipment, saying the operator continued to use radio spectrum illegally despite repeated directives to cease operations.

CRAN said it cancelled all spectrum licences issued to UCOM, formerly MTN Business Solutions Namibia, on 16 February and 8 December 2023 due to unpaid licence fees and inefficient use of the allocated spectrum, which the regulator described as "hoarding" and a breach of licence conditions.

To limit disruption for UCOM's approximately 1,000 customers, CRAN granted the company six months until June 2024 to migrate its users and orderly wind up operations. The regulator said all services were expected to terminate after this period.

However, CRAN said spectrum audits conducted in July, September and October 2025 found that UCOM was still providing services in contravention of section 101(1) of the Communications Act of 2009.

The regulator said it had issued an instruction on 3 October 2025 ordering UCOM to immediately cease using any radio frequency spectrum and to submit written confirmation within 24 hours. According to




CRAN, the company failed to comply.


CRAN stated that UCOM's continued illegal transmission is now interfering with the networks of licensed operators and affecting service quality for consumers.

The regulator said radio equipment was confiscated during an operation conducted with the assistance of the Namibian Police, in line with section 102 of the Communications Act. CRAN said this action effectively shuts down UCOM's network and prohibits further operations.

"This decision was not taken lightly but is necessary to protect the proper use of radio spectrum and to ensure better service for customers," said Mufaro Nesongano, Executive for Communication and Consumer Relations at CRAN.

He said UCOM had been given sufficient time since December 2023 to address its compliance issues but failed to do so.



## Strong demand pushes Swakopmund building approvals to surge 119%

**S**wakopmund's property market has recorded higher building activity despite a decline in the overall value of approved projects, with approvals totalling N\$734 million year to date compared to N\$2.6 billion in 2024.

Analysts say the trend reflects sustained investor confidence in the town.

According to Almandro Jansen, Economist at Simonis Storm, the coastal town has recorded a significant increase in building plan approvals, signalling positive investor sentiment.

Jansen said Swakopmund processed an average of 78 building approvals per month between January and October 2025,

totalling 783 to date, compared to 524 over the same period in 2024.

In October alone, approvals rose by 80%, increasing from 85 to 153 plans, representing a year-on-year rise of 119% from 70 approvals in October 2024.

"The 2025 trend reflects a more balanced and sustainable project pipeline, characterised by steady residential construction, incremental commercial developments, and early preparatory activity in anticipation of longer-term opportunities linked to the Walvis Bay-Swakopmund corridor and southern coastal developments," said Jansen.

In the same month, 85 projects were completed, valued at N\$83 million. Residential construction led activity, including 36 houses, 16 extensions, 36 flats and one institutional build.

Jansen said the performance aligns with broader coastal housing trends, with the latest FNB House Price Index showing a 1.2% increase in average home prices over the last year. "Swakopmund continues to benefit from strong foreign demand. Sustained interest from international buyers, combined with growing local demand for rental properties, has underpinned a 41.5% year-on-year increase in transaction volumes across small and medium market segments," he said.

Jansen added that ongoing tourism demand, residential relocations and positioning for future large-scale investments along the coast are supporting confidence in the sector. He said similar trends are expected to extend to Lüderitz as green hydrogen and related infrastructure projects advance.

"Swakopmund is emerging as a secondary growth pole along Namibia's coastline, with opportunities expanding in residential, logistics, and hospitality developments. Spillover from anticipated port-related and green-energy initiatives will further support this trajectory," Jansen said.

He noted that Lüderitz, although not yet reflected strongly in current building statistics, is becoming a strategically important construction hub.

"What the numbers don't fully capture yet is the scale of the project pipeline now converging on the south — a combination of NamPower's grid expansion, Namport's harbour upgrades, and government's green hydrogen and town-readiness agenda," he said.

Jansen concluded that together, these developments indicate a structural shift in future construction trends, moving away from a purely real-estate-driven cycle towards a longer-term, infrastructure-led investment phase.
