Thank you for your email and for following up regarding the requested consent letter from the !Khoru !Goreb Conservancy in relation to Belmont Mineral Exploration (Pty) Ltd and EPL 9987.

The Conservancy is willing to engage constructively with the proponent and the consultant. However, a consent letter cannot be issued as a simple administrative formality. The request must first go through the Conservancy's internal governance process, including review by the Conservancy leadership and, where necessary, consultation with affected members and stakeholders.

Before a meeting can be arranged, kindly provide the following information and documents:

1. A formal written request addressed to the !Khoru !Goreb Conservancy Chairperson/Conservancy Management Committee.
2. A copy of the EPL 9987 licence or official confirmation of the EPL.
3. A clear map showing the EPL boundaries and the exact overlap with the !Khoru !Goreb Conservancy area.
4. The Background Information Document, scoping report, draft EIA/ESIA documents, and draft Environmental Management Plan, if already available.
5. A detailed exploration work programme, including proposed activities such as mapping, sampling, trenching, drilling, access roads, temporary camps, fuel storage, water use, and waste management.
6. Details of the expected environmental, wildlife, grazing, tourism, heritage, water, and community impacts.
7. A rehabilitation plan, including how disturbed areas, drill sites, trenches, tracks and waste will be managed and restored.
8. Details of proposed local employment, local procurement, community benefits, grievance handling, and communication arrangements.

9. Confirmation of engagements already held with the Traditional Authority, affected land users, farmers, conservancy members, and other interested and affected parties.
10. The specific wording or purpose for which the requested Conservancy consent letter is required.

Once these documents are received, the Conservancy will review them and arrange a meeting with the proponent and consultant. The purpose of the meeting will be for Belmont Mineral Exploration (Pty) Ltd to present the proposed activities, answer questions, and allow the Conservancy leadership to understand the full implications of the proposed exploration.

Please note that any consent or no-objection letter, if considered, will be subject to the Conservancy's internal decision-making process and may include conditions relating to environmental protection, wildlife corridors, grazing areas, water points, community consultation, access control, rehabilitation, local employment, and compliance with all applicable laws and approvals.

For clarity, support from the Traditional Authority and support from the Conservancy are separate matters. Traditional Authority engagement is important for land and community leadership issues, while the Conservancy must also consider conservation, wildlife, tourism, community benefit and land-use impacts within its recognised area. The Conservancy therefore cannot be disregarded where the EPL overlaps or affects the Conservancy area.

We remain available to engage in good faith. Kindly submit the requested documents at least seven days before the proposed meeting date so that the Conservancy leadership can review them properly.



