Environmental Impact Assessment for a 20MW Solar Power Plant close to Omsa Sub-station in the vicinity of the Omsa Village and Okhondja, in the Oromia Region.

Notice is hereby given that an application for an Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) will be submitted to the Environmental Commission in terms of the Environmental Management Act, 2007 (Act No. 7 of 2007) and the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (CN 38 of 2012) for the proposed project described below.

**Proposed Activity:**

Development of a 20 MW Solar Photovoltaic (PV) Power Plant (including associated infrastructure such as internal access roads, PV arrays, inverter stations, boundary fencing, temporary construction lodges, etc., and grid connection infrastructure where applicable).

**Project Location:**

The proposed solar power plant area is located approximately 38 km west of Omsa Village on the road towards Gama Barama. The site is on the left-hand side of the A1 road connecting from Weybuck. Access is obtained by turning left from the A1 onto the D1972 district road and heading for approximately 14 km west from Gama Barama.
