SUBJECT: NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED EXTRACTION OF INDUSTRIAL MINERALS (MICA) FROM MINING CLAIM NO. 74840, 74841 AND 74843 ON A PRIVATE FARM IN KARIBIB CONSTITUENCY

This correspondence is submitted on behalf of Mr. Tjiuee. K. Kaura, the project proponent, to formally notify your good office of a proposed small-scale mica mining project to be undertaken within Mining Claim Numbers 74081, 7482 and 7483, located on a private farm in the Karibib Constituency, Erongo Region.

The proposed activity entails controlled, low-intensity surface extraction of industrial minerals (mica) within the specified mining claims. Operations will be temporary and no permanent structures will be established on site, and no blasting will be conducted. Mining will be undertaken using light mechanical methods, with progressive rehabilitation implemented as work advances to facilitate natural recovery of disturbed areas.

This notice forms part of an Environmental Clearance Certificate application being processed in accordance with the Environmental Management Act No: 7 of 2007 and its Regulations of 2012. Clearance has been obtained from the Namibia Heritage Council and the Ministry of Industries, Mines and Energy. The motivation for the project is to responsibly utilise locally available mineral resources to contribute to regional economic activities.

Given the background above, Mr. Tjiuee. K. Kaura kindly request the Council's inputs in terms of this proposed development in the region. The Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and Environmental Management Plan (EMP) report is attached to this letter which contain more details of this project.
