Dear Esteemed Interested & Affected Party,

This email serves to inform you that Mobile Telecommunication Company (MTC) (The Proponent) is proposing for the Environmental Scoping Assessment (ESA) for the Proposed Construction and Operation of a 60m Lattice Telecommunication Tower located in **Iikokola** Village and the Decommissioning/ closure plan for the Orangea Telecommunication Tower, in Omusati Region.

Telecommunication tower and related infrastructure developments are some of the listed activities that cannot be undertaken without an Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC) as per the 2012 Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations of the Environmental Management Act No. 7 of 2007. The Proponent, therefore, appointed Excel Dynamic Solutions (Pty) Ltd, an independent environmental consulting firm, to conduct the required Environmental Scoping Assessment (ESA) process and apply for the ECC.

Furthermore, Sections 21 to 24 of the EIA Regulations require that Public Consultation is undertaken as one of the crucial components of the Environmental Assessment, which involves the pre-identification of potential Interested & Affected Parties (I&APs) or Stakeholders and ongoing registration of new I&APs and subsequent consultation. You have therefore been identified as a potential I&AP for this proposed activity, and the reasons you are receiving this communication. Please find the attached Background Information Document (BID) and Site Notice for the proposed project. Once the ESA process is completed, a draft ESA Report will be compiled and, together with its associated documents/appendices, will be shared with you for review and comments before we submit these to the Department of Environmental Affairs (DEA) of the Ministry of Environment and Tourism (MET) for evaluation and consideration of the ECC.
