

REQUIREMENTS TO REGISTER AS A VOTER: LOCAL AUTHORITY ELECTION
PROOF OF RESIDENCE FOR THE LAST 12 MONTHS

In order to register as a voter in a local authority, an applicant should be able to provide the following document:

- 1. Municipality Bill
- 2. Telephone Bill
- 3. Lease Agreement
- 4. Statement under oath by applicant

In respect of proof of residence and registration of Defence Force, Police and Namibia Correctional Services Members, the applicant must produce the following documents:

- 1. Proof of membership and an affidavit sworn by the commanding officer bearing testimony as a person's community or local authority area
- 2. Accounts payable by the member in such force or to the State

In respect of proof of residence and registration of persons at schools or higher education institutions, the applicant must produce the following documents:

- 1. Proof of registration
- 2. Any statement of registration
