RE: WRITTEN NOTICE TO TRADITIONAL AUTHORITY – ENVIRONMENTAL CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE (ECC) APPLICATION FOR PROPOSED EXPLORATION ACTIVITIES: EXCLUSIVE PROSPECTING LICENCE (EPL) 9892, ǀKARAS REGION

This letter serves as formal written notice that **Profile Energy (Pty) Ltd** (the “Proponent”) intends to undertake mineral exploration activities under **Exclusive Prospecting Licence (EPL) 9892** in the **ǀKaras Region, Namibia**, and is in the process of applying for an **Environmental Clearance Certificate (ECC)** in terms of the **Environmental Management Act, 2007 (Act No. 7 of 2007)** and the Environmental Impact Assessment Regulations (2012), as applicable.

The purpose of this notice is to formally inform the Traditional Authority of the proposed activities within the area of jurisdiction (where applicable), to request the Traditional Authority’s participation in the consultation process, and to request **acknowledgement and/or consent** where such consent is required or customary for access and activities on communal land or land under traditional governance.

1. Proposed activities (summary)

The proposed exploration programme under EPL9892 may include the following (as applicable to the target areas and subject to approvals):

- Desktop studies and ground truthing;
- Access using existing roads/tracks and limited, controlled off-road access only where necessary;
- Geological mapping and prospecting;
- Surface sampling (soil, rock-chip, stream sediment/lag sampling);
- Geophysical surveys (if required);
- Limited, temporary support areas (where required); and
- Rehabilitation of any disturbed areas in accordance with the Environmental Management Plan (EMP).

The Proponent commits to implementing appropriate environmental controls, including footprint control, waste management, spill prevention, rehabilitation, and community safety measures as set out in the EMP.

2. Project location

EPL9892 is situated in the **!Karas Region**. A locality map and/or spatial description of the licence area and proposed target blocks can be provided to the Traditional Authority upon request, and the relevant maps will be included in the ECC application documentation.

3. Request for engagement, acknowledgement and/or consent

The Proponent respectfully requests:

1. A meeting or engagement opportunity with the Traditional Authority (at your convenience) to present the proposed activities and receive guidance on local protocols; and
2. Written **acknowledgement** of this notice and, where applicable, written **consent** for the proposed exploration activities to proceed within areas under the Traditional Authority's jurisdiction, subject to the granting of the ECC and any other statutory approvals.

4. How to provide comments or requirements

The Traditional Authority is invited to submit any comments, conditions, or requirements that should be considered as part of the ECC process, including any community sensitivities, cultural heritage considerations, grazing/water point use, access protocols, or timing restrictions.

Written comments or requirements may be submitted to the Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) using the contact details below within **[14] days** of receipt of this notice, or by **[18 December 2025]**.

We thank the Traditional Authority for its attention and participation, and we look forward to engaging constructively to ensure that the proposed activities are planned and implemented responsibly and with due consideration of local governance processes and community interests.
