2.1 Title of Activity

2.2 Location of Activity

The proposed site is located at coordinates (-18.674773° 13.924847°), 1.2 km west of Ombombo, within the Okangundumba Conservancy in Kunene Region, as shown in **Figure 1** of the Background Information Document (BID) attached hereto.

2.3 Nature of Activity

The nature of the proposed activity is infrastructure development, i.e., the planned construction of a 60 m Lattice (network) tower and its eventual operations:

2.4 Scale and Scope of the Activity

The proposed activity will entail the construction and operational as well as maintenance works of the telecommunication tower in Ombombo, Kunene Region. The scale of activity is considered small-scale because the project structure (tower) is localized. The duration of the proposed construction activities is about three months. The planned activities, required resources, and infrastructure are provided in the BID.

The scope of the proposed works will entail the following:

- There will be minimal earthworks to prepare the sites for the towers' construction and installation. The construction work is expected to be completed within 3 months. The structures of the towers will be mounted on a concrete foundation and will not require any supporting cables. The physical assembling of the network structure and the construction of the foundations will take place on the sites by using manual labour as far as possible.
- For safety and security reasons, the tower sites will be fenced off. This will also be done to ensure that access to the towers is limited to authorised personnel (such as the maintenance team) only and to prevent vandalism of the towers and their associated accessories.
- MTC will appoint contractors to carry out the construction. This work will be carried out during weekdays only and between 08h00 and 17h00. Preference for the construction works will be given to locals, i.e., contractors from Kunene.
- The appointed construction contractors will not be housed on sites but in their homes (for the locals) and in available accommodation facilities in Windhoek for out-of-town technical staff (if necessary). Therefore, no campsites related to the proposed projects (tower constructions) will be set up on sites nor their vicinities.
- The appointed contractor will be required to provide appropriate and sufficient Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to all its employees while carrying out the construction works at the sites
