## APPLY FOR EVENT HOSTING IN SWAKOPMUND 2026/27

The main consideration for any event being staged in Swakopmund is the safety of the participants and the public and to ensure that the planning and permission have been given well in advance with the aim to ensure that Council is prepared. Please confirm that you know at which venue or public open space you wish to host your event once you apply.

Submit a letter of application to host an Event and provide as much information as possible about your event to speed up the approval process without any delay.

### Requirements:

- A formal written application detailing the name and contact numbers of the organizer.
- Description of event: International, National, Local, Sponsoring/Branded event & Purpose of the event to be hosted
- Event Type: Sport/Action, Concert/Music Festival, Carnival/Festival, Weddings/Birthdays, Ceremonial/Annual Rituals, Awards/Launch/Exhibitions, Corporate/Private Functions, Night Market/Street Markets/Markets, Cultural/Monumental events, Shows/Expo's etc.
- Dates, duration (daily), Start and End time
- Locality/Area, Venue,
- Anticipated number of participants & number of vendors/stalls
- Draft Event Programme
- Branding requirements, e.g., banner placement etc.
- Draft/proposed Layout Plan for an event at the requested venue
- Event Safety Plan: Medical, Security, Emergency etc.
- Transport Management Plan: Routes for events, road closure, parking plan/area
- Traffic Management Plan: Road signage, marshaling plan (if applicable)
- Health Requirements: Ablution facilities, Caterers, including licenses - Food Vendors
- Council Service Requirements: Waste removal, venue cleaning & water provision

# Maswahu to Tackle DRC Woes

**“The struggles of DRC residents are both seen and heard. From the Constituency Office’s perspective, our response is structured around both short-term relief measures and long-term sustainable development interventions.”**

These were the words of Swakopmund Constituency Councillor and Member of Parliament, Victor Maswahu on questions sent to him regarding the upliftment of the poverty-struck DRC informal settlement in Swakopmund.

**For Walvis Bay born Edgar Rui Rafael (37) life started spiralling downwards since the age of 16. According to him he then started hanging out with wrong friends and subsequently got hooked on cigarettes, marijuana, mandrax and cocaine.**

“Life was not easy at all because of my addictions, and I started to break into houses and steal anything I could see so I can satisfy my cravings, and I ended getting arrested for theft,” Rafael told Namib Times. He was sentenced to two years in prison. When he was released from prison, he apparently had to face new challenges, because of the bad choices he made prior to his arrest. “People started to reject me and even my friends didn’t want to be associated with me. I was so depressed and I ended up drinking Jik to commit suicide, but I survived the suicide attempt,” Rafael remarked. He then realized that he needed to make drastic changes in his life, and

although it wasn’t easy at all and only by the grace of God he managed to overcome, Rafael recalls. He is currently ordained as a pastor and employed at a well-known building materials supplier in Ondangwa. He is married, and according to him his wife and 6-year-old daughter played a vital role in his transformation. “I want to encourage the youth out there that alcohol and drug abuse is not the way. Only when you surrender your life unto Christ, you’ll truly be free. If He could have done it for me, He can also do it for you. With God anything is possible,” is Rafael’s message to the youth.
