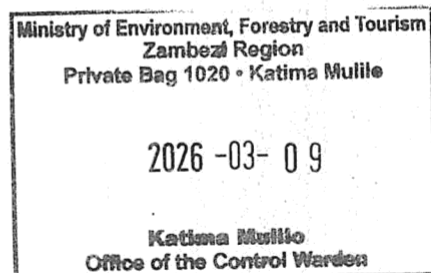

**NOTIFICATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL SCOPING AND INVITATION FOR COMMENTS OR SUPPORT ON THE PROPOSED RENOVATION PROJECT TO UPGRADE MAVUNDJE CAMPSITE TO A LODGE, NGONGA AREA, JUDEA LYABOLOMA CONSTITUENCY**
