



## CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO WHOLESALE LICENCE

### General Conditions

1. *The wholesale licence-holder must at all times comply with the Petroleum Products and Energy Act, the Petroleum Products Regulations (2000) and all other applicable laws, including laws relating to labour, safety, hazardous substances, security, health and environment.*
2. *The wholesale licence-holder may sell fuel only in bulk quantities.*
3. *If the wholesale licence-holder sells fuel to any person other than a retail licence-holder, certificate-holder, Government institution, local authority or regional council, the provisions of regulation 8 of the Petroleum Products Regulations (2000), apply with the necessary changes.*
4. *The sale of fuel to a person referred to in condition 3 may not be made from any other place than from a dispensing point situated at the relevant premises of the wholesaler.*
5. *All relevant import and export and wholesale sale, of fuel, approvals and permits as required under the Petroleum Products and Energy Act or any other applicable law must be obtained prior to any import into, export from or wholesale sale of fuel in Namibia.*
6. *The wholesale licence-holder must keep such records and must submit such information to the Minister as are required under the Petroleum Products Regulations (2000).*
7. *Petroleum products imported or distributed must comply with approved specifications as made applicable by or under the Petroleum Products Regulations (2000).*
8. *The wholesale licence-holder may not abandon storage facilities otherwise than in accordance with the Petroleum Products Regulations (2000).*
9. *All applicable duties, levies and taxes must be paid to the relevant authorities and bodies.*
10. *The wholesale licence-holder must inform the Minister in writing of any changes to be affected to storage facilities prior to effecting such changes.*
11. *The wholesale licence-holder must inform the Minister as soon as possible of any dangerous situation arising from the conduct of activities authorised under the licence, including the steps taken or proposed to be taken by the licence-holder to rectify such situation or to eliminate or minimise the danger arising from such situation.*
12. *The wholesale licence-holder must comply with all provisions of the Petroleum Products Regulations relating to petroleum product spills.*

2. *Importation*
3. *Exportation*
4. *The wholesale license must be done in full compliance with environmental conditions set by the Ministry of Environment and Tourism*
5. *According to the Amended Petroleum Products Regulations the Minister may change these conditions retroactively at any time*

### IMPORT APPROVAL: PETROLEUM PRODUCTS

Your letter dated 16 July 2024 refers.

Authority to import the under mentioned petroleum products from South Africa, United Arab Emirates, Russia, Europe, Saudi Arabia, Canada, Venezuela, Iran, Nigeria, Algeria, and Qatar via port of Walvis Bay.

• Diesel (50 PPM)	200 000 000 litres per annum
• ULP 95	50 000 000 litres per annum
• HFO	70 000 000 liters per annum
• Jet Fuel	50 000 000 liters per annum
• Aviation Lubricants	50 000 000 litres per annum
• Bitumen	10 000 000 litres per annum

The importation of the abovementioned petroleum products is subject to the following conditions:

- That the fuel imported from other sources than the RSA must comply with the specification of the local market.
- That equalization fund levies on sales of imported fuels must be paid to the National Energy Fund [NEF].
- Taxation and Customs and Excise Duty must be paid to the Ministry of Finance [Customs and Excise].

All official correspondence must be addressed to the Executive Director

- That the free flow of fuel to Namibia must not be jeopardized, however, should a situation arise which in view of the Ministry of Mines and Energy does jeopardize the market, this authority will be re-considered or if necessary withdrawn.
- That import permits for the import of controlled petroleum fuels are to be obtained from the Ministry of Industrialization, Trade and SME Development before any arrangements can be finalized.

The following information and documentation is required by the Ministry of Mines and Energy during the import process.

- Prices quoted at the time of ordering.
- Price quotation when loading the ship.
- The Bill of Lading and the Bill of entry.
- Copies of all the invoices.
- Documentary proof of specification must reach the Ministry of Mines and Energy before the product is accepted at a Namibian port.

The importation of controlled fuels should be destined for the Namibian market, unless prior permission is obtained to tranship petroleum products to other markets in the region.

### **PERMISSION TO EXPORT PETROLEUM FUELS OUTSIDE NAMIBIA**

1. Permission is hereby granted to Earthways Group Investments CC to export the following petroleum products for the period of 12 months expiring on 04 September 2025.

- **ADO (500 PPM)**      **200 000 000 liters**
- **ADO (50PPM)**      **200 000 000 liters**
- **ULP 95**              **50 000 000 liters**
- **Aviation Lubricants**   **50 000 000 liters**
- **Jet Fuel**              **50 000 000 liters**
- **HFO**                  **50 000 000 liters**
- **Bitumen**              **20 000 000 liters**

2. The permit is to export to Botswana, Zambia, Zimbabwe, DRC, South Africa, Lesotho via Vioolsdrift, Ariamsvlei, Noordoewer, Mamuno/Buitepos, Muhembo, Trans Kalahari Border Post, Ngoma and Wenela borders.

3. Earthways Group Investments CC must adhere to the following conditions in the execution of this export.

3.1 Trade permit shall be obtained from the Ministry of Trade and Industry, a copy of which is to be supplied to Ministry of Mines and Energy.

All official correspondence must be addressed to the Executive Director

- 3.2 Earthways Group Investments CC and prices quoted shall be revealed in writing to Ministry of Mines and Energy.
- 3.3 The price shall include all basic purchase cost, transport, sea leakage, insurance, wharfage and bridging cost.
- 3.4 Trades on an 'In Bond' basis shall be cleared with Customs and Excise, for the relief of fuel taxation as well as customs and excise levies by Earthways Group Investments CC.
- 3.5 All foreign permits or restrictions in terms of containers or transport will be the responsibility of Earthways Group Investments CC and shall be adhered to.
- 3.6 A bunkering permit must be obtained from Ministry of Works and Transport (Maritime Affairs)
4. Non-compliance with any of these conditions may result in the cancellation of this permission.

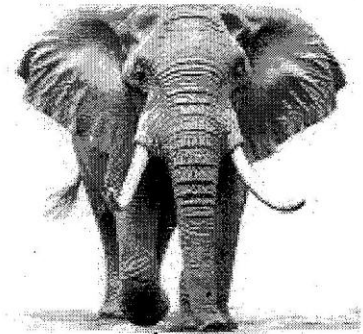



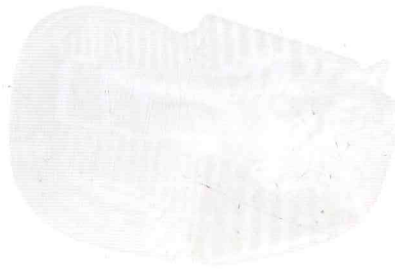
