Request for input and comments on the proposed Construction of Telecommunication Towers at Amaupa village -Omusati region, Shanondho Village- Kavango-East region and Masida village-Zambezi region.

PowerCom (Pty) Ltd intends to construct three new telecommunication lattice towers in the following areas.

The proposed new telecommunication towers are part of the company's strategic plan to increase network coverage nationwide. All sites are expected to be connected to the national grid, with power sourced from the nearest NORED power lines.

In terms of the Environmental Management Act (Act No.07 of 2007), and Schedule 10 (10.1 (g) the construction of *Communication networks including towers, telecommunication and marine telecommunication lines and cables* cannot be undertaken without any Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) being undertaken. Green Gain Consultants cc was appointed by PowerCom (Pty) Ltd to conduct the required EIA study of the proposed activities.

As part of the EIA study, we are writing to obtain your input and comments on the proposed activities, and to confirm the availability of a sufficient power supply at the respective sites to accommodate the proposed towers.
